Every year, 10 million tonnes of wood is disposed of in the UK, yet only 1.5 million tonnes is recycled.

Ward recycles all wood waste including used delivery pallets, manufacturing waste, processed wood, such as chipboard, compressed and bonded wood composites, plywood and MDF. We can process preservative-treated off-cuts and all untreated wood from a variety of industries.

We also work with green wood waste from tree surgery, landscaping and gardening.

Around 38% (c.1.1mt, 2010) of all recycled wood is used in the UK manufacture of particleboard.
